There are three main points to consider when evaluating authoring tools for creating multi-device e-learning:

- 1. Courses must work across any internet-enabled device with any form factor.
- 2. You, the course developer, shouldn't have to manually adjust or create courses to fit each device a learner might use.
- 3. Courses should take advantage of all possible screen real estate and provide natural, intuitive navigation.
